

Postdoctoral position in post-fire boreal forest dynamics

We are looking for a postdoctoral fellow to collaborate on the analysis of large existing datasets focused on forest recovery following wildfire and to establish field-based investigations post-fire regeneration failure and/or impacts of fire-permafrost interactions on regeneration processes in the Northwest Territories, Canada. The candidate would also have the opportunity to collaborate on the integration of results from these studies within boreal forest dynamics models under development at the Canadian Forest Service.

Required skills: A PhD in ecology, environmental science, or closely related field; strong statistical expertise; excellence in written English; a record of high-quality peer-reviewed publications. Experience in boreal forests and/or fire ecology is an asset.
